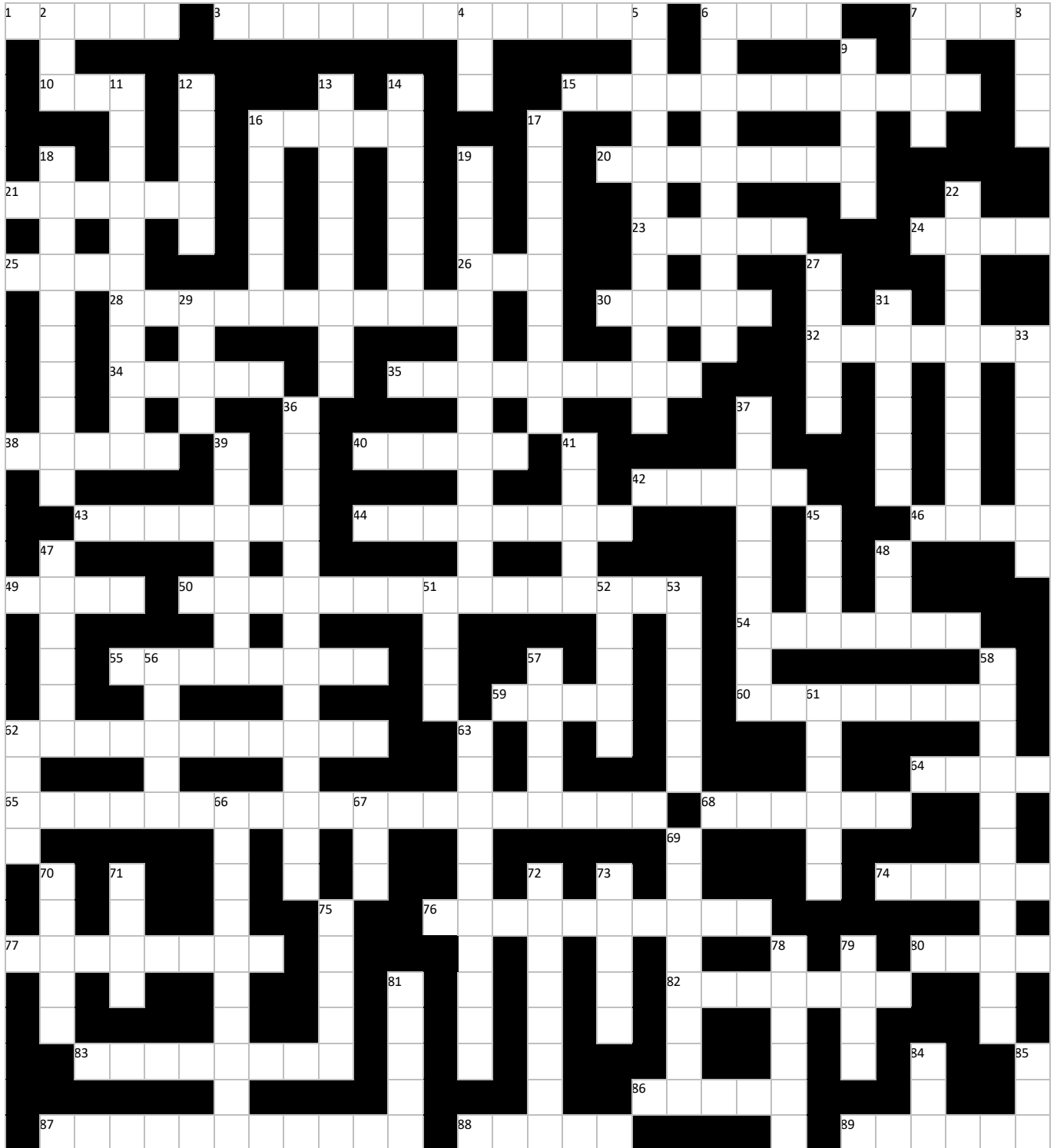


Crossword
