Agriculture

This report captures workers engaged in growing crops, raising animals, growing and harvesting timber as well as those harvesting fish and other animals from farms or their natural habitats.

SafeWork SA inspectors ensure breaches of work health and safety laws and public safety standards are detected are met with appropriate action taken.

There has been a significant focus on education and proactive work in this sector.

During July, inspectors progressed development of a compliance and enforcement approach for roll-over

protection devices on tractors given the transitional clause will end on 31 December 2016.

Inspectors have also been planning a joint audit in mid September with the Australian Maritime Safety Authority (AMSA) focussing on the use of safety bars, fishing nets and roller mechanisms on fishing vessels across the tuna, prawn, rock lobster and oyster sector.

Proactive compliance visit to workplaces in this industry group will increase in the coming months.
