## Manufacturing

This report covers people working with machinery and plant, factories or mills to assemble products for sale.

SafeWork SA inspectors ensure work health and safety and public safety standards are met and take appropriate action when breaches are detected.

In November, our inspectors attended numerous incidents including:

- hitting or being hit by moving equipment
- lacerations using hand-held plant
- minor electric shocks from equipment
- unsafe/incorrect work procedures
- machinery not maintained

- inadequate machine guarding
- falling objects from poorly maintained storage areas
- dislodged ceiling panels falling
- suspended loads over persons
- safety warning equipment inoperable
- structure being hit by moving plant
- asbestos dust in the workplace
- absence of safe systems of work
- unsafe access/egress.
