Road transport

This report covers workers who provide transport services for passengers and freight. This includes postal services, pipeline transport, scenic and sightseeing transport, warehousing and storage.

SafeWork SA inspectors ensure work health and safety and public safety standards are met and take appropriate action when breaches are detected.

In November, our inspectors investigated incidents including:

- collisions between mobile plant, or mobile and fixed plant
- loads falling from forklifts/pallet jacks
- workers being hit by vehicles

- inadequate maintenance of mobile plant
- non-compliant plant/machinery
- poor manual task design
- falls from plant/equipment
- fire in plant
- poor traffic management
- allegedly being under the influence of alcohol or a drug at work.
